**A Resolution in Support of the Reinstatement of State Historic Tax Credits
Senate Bill 469 and House Bill 5178**

At a meeting of the Charter Township of Oakland Historic District Commission, Oakland County, Michigan, held on May 16, 2018.

WHEREAS, the preservation of our heritage and historic resources is in the public interest so that its legacy of cultural, educational, and economic benefits will be maintained and enriched for future generations; and

WHEREAS, the historic buildings, neighborhoods and places in Michigan distinguish each community, provide character and a sense of place that contribute significantly to the quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the preservation and rehabilitation of historic buildings, places and neighborhoods contributes to the beauty, character, and economic vitality of Michigan communities; and


WHEREAS, the Michigan Legislature is presently considering Senate Bill 469 and House Bill 5178 that would reinstate an up-to-25 percent investment tax credit for owners of local historic residential and commercial properties who substantially rehabilitate their properties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Charter Township of Oakland Historic District Commission endorses and supports both Senate Bill 469 and House Bill 5178 and calls upon the Michigan Legislature to pass this important legislation and Governor Snyder to sign it, in order to stimulate appropriate development and redevelopment and protect the historic character and quality of life of our communities.
